

93B: Pittsfield fine sandy loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes

The Pittsfield component makes up 85 percent of the map unit. The natural drainage class is well drained. Water movement in the most restrictive layer is moderately high. This component is on hills on glaciated uplands, knolls on glaciated uplands. The parent material consists of loamy till. Depth to a root restrictive layer is greater than 60 inches.

Vermont Residential Onsite Waste Disposal Group and Subgroup: Ic

This unit is well suited as a site for soil-based residential wastewater disposal systems, based on a review by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of criteria set forth in the Vermont 2007 Environmental Protection Rules. With moderate permeability and slopes less than 20 percent, there are few limitations.
