

WyF. Woodstock-Rock outcrop complex, 25 to 60 percent slopes

The Rock outcrop component makes up 50 percent of the map unit. Water movement in the most restrictive layer is low. This component is on mountains on glaciated uplands, hills on glaciated uplands. Depth to a root restrictive layer0 inches, bedrock, lithic..

The Woodstock component makes up 40 percent of the map unit. The natural drainage class is somewhat excessively drained. Water movement in the most restrictive layer is low. This component is on mountains on glaciated uplands, hills on glaciated uplands. The parent material consists of coarse-loamy till. Depth to a root restrictive layer, bedrock, lithic, is 10 to 20 inches.

This unit is generally not suited as a site for soil-based residential wastewater disposal systems, based on a review by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of criteria set forth in the Vermont 2007 Environmental Protection Rules. Steep slopes in association with the depth to bedrock is the limiting condition. Cut and fill site modifications that reduce the slope gradient are difficult to achieve due to the depth to bedrock.
