

21A: Sunday fine sand, 0 to 3 percent slopes

The Sunday component makes up 85 percent of the map unit. The natural drainage class is excessively drained. Water movement in the most restrictive layer is high. This component is on flood plains on river valleys. The parent material consists of sandy alluvium. Depth to a root restrictive layer is greater than 60 inches.

This unit is marginally suited as a site for soil-based residential wastewater disposal systems, based on a review by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of criteria set forth in the Vermont 2007 Environmental Protection Rules. The hazard of flooding is the major limitation. This unit is on floodplains and typically includes land in the floodway and the special flood hazard area. Consult flood hazard maps prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in local town offices for more information. Wastewater systems must be located, designed and constructed in a manner that avoids impairment to the system and contamination from the system due to flooding.
